

## **CALL FOR APPLICATION FOR THE PARTICIPATION TO “ERASMUS+ BLENDED INTENSIVE PROGRAMME” (BIP) AT ESCUELA DE ARQUITECTURA DE TOLEDO (SPAIN).**

The call for applications is hereby published for the participation to “Erasmus+ Blended Intensive Program (BIP)” in **“Flood as an opportunity”**, from **15.07.2024** to **26.07.2024**. It will take place at the **Escuela De Arquitectura De Toledo (Spain)**.

BIPs are short-term Intensive Study Programs, which include in-person and online attendance and in-person and online lessons.

Under the title **“Flood as an opportunity”**, the meeting will try to orient the online training and the face-to-face workshops towards **a positive vision of flooding as a solution to the long periods of drought** that are being established. Trying to find urban and architectural solutions that manage to receive large amounts of rain in a positive way in a short space of time and to store it for its use during periods of low rainfall.

The call, having deadline on **june 11th 2024**, is addressed to staff and students from the University of Naples Federico II. The students, at the moment of application, have to be regularly enrolled in one of the following courses:

- ARC 5UE (Corso di Laurea Magistrale in Architettura a c.u.)
- SdA (Corso di Laurea triennale in Scienze dell’Architettura);
- MAPA/ACTA (Corso di Laurea Magistrale in Architettura Progettazione Architettonica / Corso di Laurea Magistrale in Architettura per Comunità, Territori, Ambiente);
- ARCHER (Corso di Laurea Magistrale in Architecture & Heritage);
- PTUPA Corso di Laurea Magistrale in Pianificazione Territoriale Urbanistica e Paesaggistico Ambientale;
- D.ARC (Dottorato di ricerca in Architettura)
- HabiT (Dottorato di Eccellenza Habitat in Transition)

In-presence activities will take place from **22.07.2024** to **26.07.2024** at the **Escuela De Arquitectura De Toledo (Spain)**. The selected students must guarantee at least 5 days in presence. From **15.07.2024** to **19.07.2024** the activities will be carried out online.

All the activities will be hold in English, thus knowledge of English language is required.

The students that will successfully complete the programme (virtual and physical mobility – both mandatory) will receive **3 ECTS**.

### **2. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

The Selection Committee will select **1** teacher staff and **5** students. Applicant students should be regularly enrolled for the a.y. 2023/24 in one of the aforementioned courses.

### **3. APPLICATION PROCEDURE**

The following documents must be provided:

*For Staff applicants:*

- Curriculum Vitae (in Italian or in English). Candidates for the staff position must have an active contract with the University of Naples Federico II, and have documented experience in teaching and architectural design.

*For Student applicants:*

- Academic career (completed exams and their scores);
  - Certificate (or self-certification) of enrollment in one of the following courses:
    - ARC 5UE (Corso di Laurea Magistrale in Architettura a c.u.);
    - SdA (Corso di Laurea triennale in Scienze dell'Architettura);

- Motivational letter in English (max 250 words);
- Project portfolio (PDF format, maximum size 3 MB)
- ID certificate

#### 4. CRITERIA FOR THE FORMULATION OF THE RANKING:

*For Staff applicants:* The Commission will prioritize teaching experiences abroad and within project workshop contexts.

*For Student applicants:* The Commission will assign the score as follows:

- Max. 60 points for the evaluation of the academic career;
- Max. 40 points for the motivational letter and project portfolio;

In case of incomplete documentation, the application will be rejected.

#### 5. PUBLICATION OF RANKINGS

Rankings will be published on the Department's websites starting from **june 12th, 2024**.

#### 6. FINANCIAL CONTRIBUTION

The selected students will be financially supported according to the norms of the Erasmus+ Programme.

The financial contribution is established as follows:

**Duration of in-person mobility: Amount**

Until the 14th day of activity 79 euro / day

From the 15th day to the 30th day of activity 56 euro / day

A one-time-only extra amount of 100€ to the individual support of the EU contribution for an in-person mobility from 5 to 14 days, or 150€ for an in-person mobility from 15 to 30 days, is also available for

students with fewer opportunities, with ISEE < €15,000 used for university purposes as submitted by the Erasmus grant winners for their latest enrolling. Students that will choose a “green” travel solution (i.e., train) will receive another extra amount of 50€ one-time-only.

Further information about the financial contribution will be provided to the students that will be selected for this programme.

Erasmus+ contributions are related to the activities abroad and to the recognition of such activities by the University. Students that will not complete all the steps will have to return the whole amount of the contribution.

Staff Contributions: The funding amount and characteristics (duration, number of teaching hours, etc.) correspond to those provided for the same type of mobility under the Erasmus+ program.

## 7. DATA PROCESSING

Information on the processing of personal data pursuant to art. 13 of Regulation (EU) 679/2016 laying down rules on the processing of personal data and the code regarding the protection of personal data, Legislative Decree No. 196/2003 supplemented and amended by Legislative Decree No. 101/2018

By filling in, delivering, and transmitting the forms required for participation in this selection notice, the student/teacher provides his personal data to the University of Naples Federico II and assumes the quality of “interested party” to the processing of such data pursuant to of the art. 4, 1) of the EU Regulation.

**PURPOSES AND MEANS OF PROCESSING:** The personal data provided during the application for participation or acquired subsequently during the relationship with the University will be processed for institutional purposes, in particular for administrative and accounting obligations related to the agreement. To this end, personal data such as name, surname, residence, personal data, tax code, contact details, address, email, data relating to the qualifications held, to the school career may be collected.

Personal data will be processed by authorised personnel both electronically, through the computerized management of the data, and in paper mode, through the collection, storage and use of documents in files, dossiers, and archives.

**MANDATORY PROVISION OF DATA AND CONSEQUENCES OF ANY REFUSAL:** the processing of personal data is mandatory for the purpose of assessing the requirements for participation in the aforementioned call. Particular categories of data (judicial data and particular state of health) are provided voluntarily to allow the University to carry out the procedure and/or the provision of the related services for participation. For these reasons, consent to the processing of data is not required. Any refusal will make it impossible for the University to fulfil these purposes and participation in the program.

**COMMUNICATION AND DISSEMINATION OF DATA:** Personal data will be processed for the performance of institutional activities according to the principles of lawfulness, necessity, non-excess, relevance and correctness, in accordance with European and national legislation and the University Regulations on the subject; the data may be disclosed in particular to the following subjects (Erasmus+ National Agency - INDIRE; European Commission, Ministry of Education, University and Research; University; Host company; Affiliated banking institution).

In compliance with the provisions on Transparent Administration (Legislative Decree No. 33/2013 and subsequent amendments) personal data, with the exception of the particular categories – referred to in articles 9 and 10 of the EU Regulation – are disseminated through publication on the university's institutional website for the period provided for by law.
