

## **CALL FOR APPLICATION FOR THE PARTICIPATION TO “ERASMUS+ BLENDED INTENSIVE PROGRAMME” (BIP) AT INSTITUTO EUROPEO DE DISEÑO (IED) BARCELONA (SPAIN).**

The call for applications is hereby published for participation in “Erasmus+ Blended Intensive Program (BIP)” in *The Future(s) of Mediterranean Food Systems*, from **23.02.2026** to **27.02.2026**. It will take place at the **Instituto Europeo de Diseño (IED) Barcelona**.

BIPs are short-term intensive study programs that include both in-person and online attendance, as well as in-person and online lessons. The BIP *The Future(s) of Mediterranean Food Systems* was created to offer an in-depth understanding of the challenges that food systems in the Mediterranean area will have to face – starting, *first and foremost*, with the now tangible effects of climate change – and to provide participants with theoretical and operational tools to respond to them through creative and sustainable solutions. With this in mind, the course integrates some of the main areas of expertise of the lecturers involved in the initiative for each institution: food design in the case of IED Barcelona, systemic and process design applied to the agri-food sector in the case of the Federico II University of Naples, and sociology and *futures studies* in the case of the Université Paris-Est Créteil.

The course structure includes an initial analytical phase dedicated to identifying the main strengths and vulnerabilities of contemporary food systems – considering production, processing, distribution, and consumption – with a specific focus on the Mediterranean area.

In the second phase, participants, organized into interdisciplinary (product design, spatial design, sociology, and social entrepreneurship) and international groups (Spain, France, Italy), will develop innovative project proposals for possible – and desirable – 'food futures' based on criteria such as biodiversity protection, economic circularity and waste minimization, social equity, sovereignty and food security.

The call, having a deadline on **January 16<sup>th</sup>, 2026** is addressed to students from the University of Naples Federico II who, at the moment of application, are regularly enrolled in one of the following courses:

- ARC 5UE (Corso di Laurea Magistrale in Architettura a c.u.)
- MAPA/ACTA (Corso di Laurea Magistrale in Architettura Progettazione Architettonica / Corso di Laurea Magistrale in Architettura per Comunità, Territori, Ambiente);
- DBE (Corso di Laurea Magistrale in Design for the Built Environment);
- CODE (Corso di Laurea triennale in Design per la Comunità);
- SdA (Corso di Laurea triennale in Scienze dell'Architettura);

In-presence activities will take place from **23.02.2026** to **27.02.2026** at the **Instituto Europeo de Diseño (IED) Barcelona**. The selected students must guarantee at least 5 days in presence. From **02.02.2026** to **12.02.2026** the activities will be carried out online. All the activities will be held exclusively in English, thus knowledge of English language is required. The students that will successfully complete the programme (virtual and physical mobility – both mandatory) will receive **3** ECTS.

### **2. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

The Selection Committee will select **5** students. Applicants should be regularly enrolled for the a.y. 2025/26 in one of the aforementioned courses.

### **3. APPLICATION PROCEDURE**

Interested students must apply by the deadline **January 16<sup>th</sup>, 2026**, sending all the documents by e-mail to: [ernestoramon.rispoli@unina.it](mailto:ernestoramon.rispoli@unina.it)

The following documents must be provided:

- Curriculum Vitae
- Documentation of the study progress (downloaded from the website SEGREPASS)
- Motivational letter in English (max 250 words)
- An English language certificate (optional)

The selection is the sole responsibility of the Erasmus committee of the Department of Architecture.

#### CRITERIA FOR THE FORMULATION OF THE RANKING

The Commission will assign the score as follows:

- Max. 40 points for the evaluation of the academic career;
- Max. 30 points for the CV;
- Max. 20 points for the motivational letter;
- Max. 10 points for the knowledge of the English language.

In case of incomplete documentation, the application will be rejected.

## 6. DATA PROCESSING

Information on the processing of personal data pursuant to art. 13 of Regulation (EU) 679/2016 laying down rules on the processing of personal data and the code regarding the protection of personal data, Legislative Decree No. 196/2003 supplemented and amended by Legislative Decree No. 101/2018. By filling in, delivering and transmitting the forms required for participation in this selection notice, the student provides his personal data to the University of Naples Federico II and assumes the quality of "interested party" to the processing of such data pursuant to of the art. 4, 1) of the EU Regulation.

**PURPOSES AND MEANS OF PROCESSING:** The personal data provided during the application for participation or acquired subsequently during the relationship with the University will be processed for institutional purposes, and administrative and accounting obligations related to the agreement. To this end, personal data such as name, surname, residence, personal data, tax code, contact details, address, email, and data relating to the qualifications held to the school career may be collected. Personal data will be processed by authorized personnel both electronically, through the computerized management of the data, and in paper mode, through the collection, storage, and use of documents in files, dossiers and archives.

**MANDATORY PROVISION OF DATA AND CONSEQUENCES OF ANY REFUSAL:** the processing of personal data is mandatory for the purpose of assessing the requirements for participation in the aforementioned call. Particular categories of data (judicial data and particular state of health) are provided voluntarily to allow the University to carry out the procedure and/or the provision of the related services for participation. For these reasons, consent to the processing of data is not required. Any refusal will make it impossible for the University to fulfill these purposes and participation in the program.
